The voting was determined by show of hands at the Meeting. The attached Schedule summarises the outcome in respect of Resolution 1. Resolutions 2, 3, 4 and 5 were withdrawn by the Company. Accordingly, the Board confirms that Resolution 1 has been passed by Shareholders regarding the issue of 62,500,000 shares to Talbot Group Investments Pty Limited.

Sundance has commenced feasibility study on the Mbalam Iron Ore Project as the basis for developing a global iron ore business. Central West Africa is considered to have the potential to develop into a significant new iron province, underpinned by the Mbalam Iron Ore Project and the nearby Belinga Project in Gabon, under development by the China National Machinery and Equipment Import and Export Corporation. WA-based Sundance has been listed on the Australian Stock Exchange since 1993 and is also traded on over-the-counter markets in Frankfurt, Berlin, Hamburg, Stuttgart and Munich.
